The Constitution

Extracts from the NCTG Constitution

Items of particular note:

- To organise and co-ordinate training and activities in or ancillary to the construction industry as may be required by the members.
- To co-operate and liaise with Training Enterprise Councils or Local Enterprise Companies in order to promote the training needs of the Construction Industry.
- To co-operate with local education and other authorities and bodies as regards the provision of facilities for basic training and further education.
- To do all such things as may be conducive to the attainment of all or any of the above objectives.
- To hold conferences, seminars, meetings, lectures courses and discussions.
- To make representations at public enquiries, appeals or in such other ways as shall appear necessary from time to time in furtherance of the objectives of the Group.
- The income and property of the Group whencesoever derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objectives of the Group as set forth in this memorandum of association and no member shall have any personal claim on any property of the Group and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise howsoever by way of profit to members of the Group.
- True accounts shall be kept of the sums of money received and expended by the Group and the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure takes place and of the property, credits and liabilities of the Group, and, subject to any reasonable restrictions as to the time and manner of inspecting the same that may be imposed in accordance with the regulations of the Group for the time being, such accounts shall be examined, and the correctness thereof and of the balance sheet ascertained by one or more auditor or auditors qualified to act as auditor under the Companies Act 1985.
