## Is your company affected by redundancies?

If you are a construction employer with workers that will be or have been affected by redundancy, we, at ConstructionSkills, can help.

To be eligible, staff must be aged 18 or over, live or work/have been working in Nottinghamshire, Leicestershire or Northamptonshire and are/have been directly employed by the company.

Sub-contractors, agency workers and temps are excluded.



## Fully funded, flexible support and training
